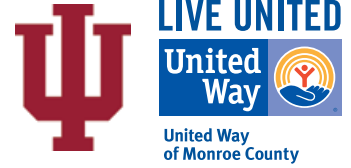

You ensure that struggling families have the essentials like food, housing, health care, and help during a crisis.



\$1

per week provides 26 healthy meals to low-income families.

Why it matters:

Locally, 41% of children qualify for free or reduced lunch at school. Those food needs don't end when the school bell rings.

\$3

per week can provide 50 door-to-door trips for a senior unable to drive.

Why it matters:

With the right modifications and support, most seniors can safely stay in their homes and avoid the cost of a nursing home.

\$8

per week can prevent homelessness for an at-risk family.

Why it matters:

42% of United Way member agency clients are employed, but often face tough choices to make ends meet.

\$25

per week provides a young child with 5 weeks of high-quality childcare.

Why it matters:

85% of brain growth happens by age 5. Robust early learning experiences are critical for kids to get a smart start in life.
