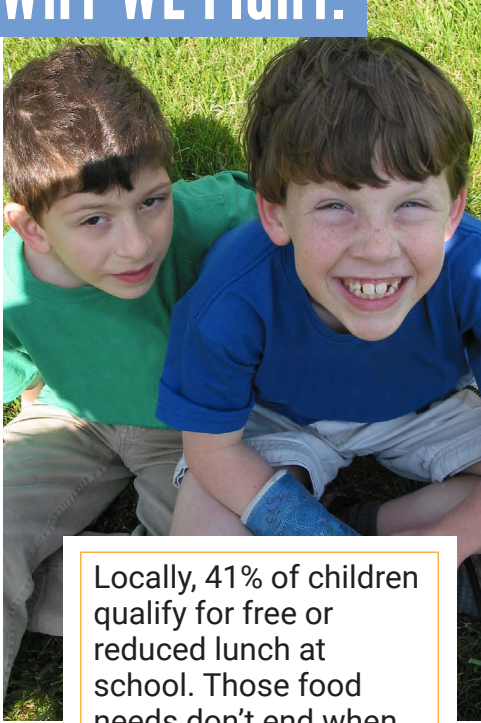

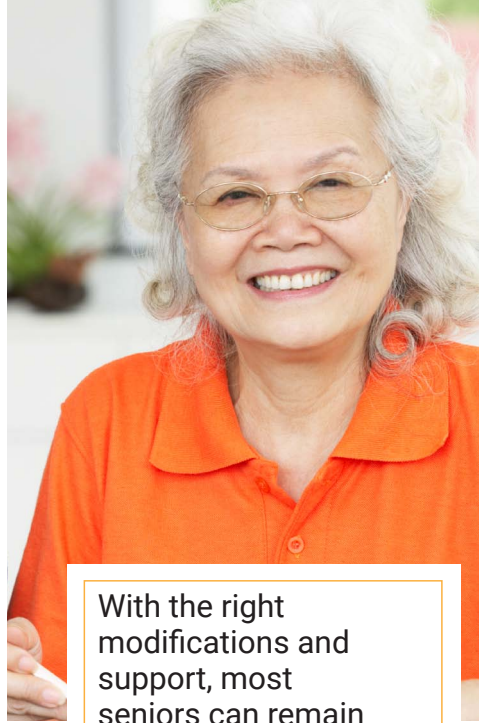

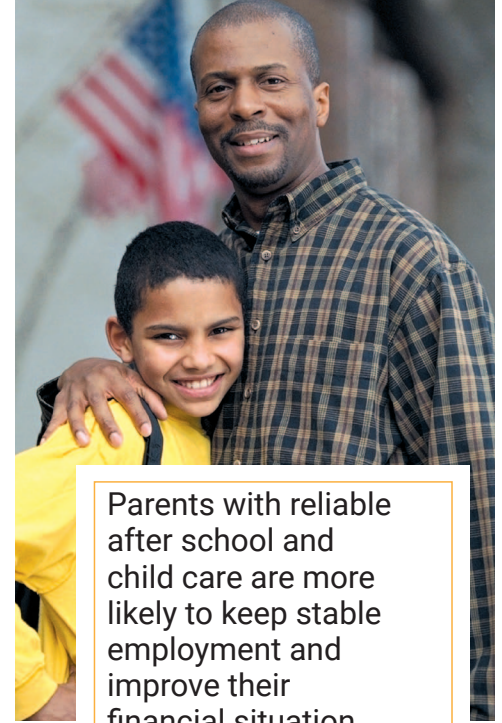
Locally, 41% of children qualify for free or reduced lunch at school. Those food needs don't end when the school bell rings.

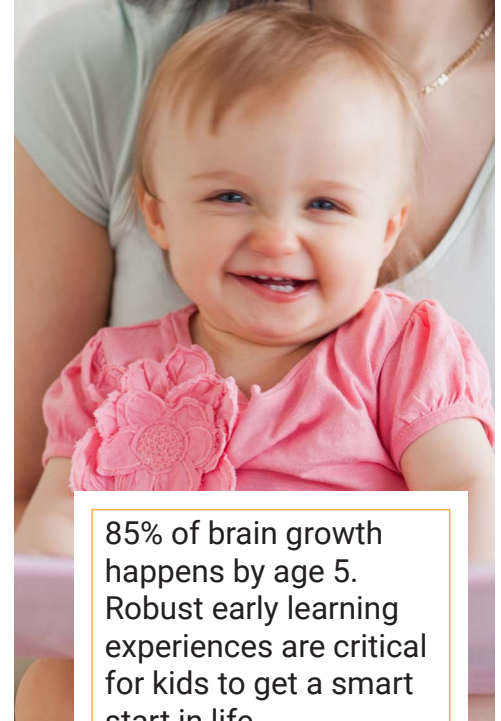
Only 24% of working age people with developmental disabilities who want jobs are employed.
